

IREM Chapter 99 Local Scholarship

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Scholarship Applicant

Q: What is the IREM Chapter 99 Local Scholarship?

A: The IREM Chapter 99 Local Scholarship is offered by the Las Vegas IREM Chapter to provide financial assistance to individuals interested in furthering their education in the field of property management.

Q: Who is eligible to apply for the Chapter 99 Local Scholarship?

A: Applicants must be current IREM and IREM Las Vegas Chapter 99 members in good standing and demonstrate merit, service, and involvement with the Las Vegas IREM Chapter. Additional eligibility requirements may be outlined in the application.

Q: What criteria are used to select scholarship recipients?

A: Scholarships are awarded based on chapter involvement, professional commitment, and overall qualifications as outlined in the application. Active participation in Chapter 99 activities and committees is a key consideration.

Q: What does the Chapter 99 Local Scholarship cover?

A: The scholarship provides financial assistance toward approved educational courses offered through the Las Vegas IREM Chapter or IREM.org. Specific award details are outlined in the scholarship application.

Q: Do I need to be involved in a Chapter 99 committee to apply?

A: No, but applicants who are actively involved in the Las Vegas IREM Chapter through committees or events will receive added consideration as stated in the application requirements.

Q: How do I apply for the Chapter 99 Local Scholarship?

A: Applicants must complete the Chapter 99 Local Scholarship application and submit all

required materials by the stated deadline. Submission instructions are included in the application.

Q: What materials are required with the application?

A: A complete application typically includes the scholarship application form, a current resume, a professional letter of reference, and a written statement addressing questions outlined by the Scholarship Committee.

Q: How will I be notified if I am selected?

A: Scholarship recipients will be notified directly by the Las Vegas IREM Chapter with award details and next steps.

Q: Is there a deadline to use the scholarship once it is awarded?

A: Yes. Scholarship awards must be used within one year after they are awarded. Funds not used within that timeframe may be forfeited.

Q: Can the scholarship be transferred to another person or applied to membership dues?

A: No. The Chapter 99 Local Scholarship is awarded to an individual recipient and may only be used for approved educational purposes as specified by the chapter.

Q: What happens if I am unable to use the scholarship after it is awarded?

A: Recipients should notify the Las Vegas IREM Chapter as soon as possible if they are unable to use the scholarship. Additional guidance will be provided based on the situation.

Q: Can I apply for other scholarships in addition to the Chapter 99 Local Scholarship?

A: Yes. Applicants are encouraged to explore other local scholarship opportunities as well as national scholarships offered through the IREM Foundation.
