Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Scholarship Applicant

Q: What is the Penny Tourangeau, CPM® Legacy Scholarship?

A: The Penny Tourangeau, CPM® Legacy Scholarship honors the life and legacy of Penny Tourangeau, a pioneering IREM educator and leader. The scholarship supports IREM members who demonstrate commitment to the advancement of real estate management, professional education, and service to the Las Vegas IREM Chapter.

Q: Who is eligible to apply for this scholarship?

A: Applicants must be current IREM members in good standing with both local and national dues paid and actively involved with Las Vegas IREM Chapter 99.

Q: What are the selection requirements for this scholarship?

A: To be considered, applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

1. Demonstrate interest in the practice and advancement of real estate management.
 2. Have attended at least four (4) chapter general meetings or events in the prior year, which may include lunches, chapter-hosted networking events, Installation, or Forecast.
 3. Submit a personal statement outlining the impact obtaining a professional designation will have on their career, community, and the real estate profession.
 4. Be a current active member of an IREM® Chapter 99 committee, with committee chair verification. Past chapter involvement may also be considered.
 5. Be current on local and national IREM membership dues.
 6. Submit a complete application, including a current resume and a professional letter of reference, by the required deadline.

Q: What materials are required with the application?

A: A complete application package must include:

- Completed scholarship application
- Current resume
- Professional letter of reference
- Personal statement as outlined above

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Q: When is the application deadline?

A: All required materials must be received by March 31st. Please allow approximately fifteen (15) business days from receipt of a complete application for processing and review.

Q: How do I submit my application?

A: Applications and all required documentation must be submitted to:

Applicants are responsible for verifying receipt of their application with the Chapter IAE.

Q: When and how is the scholarship awarded?

A: Scholarship recipients are selected by the Scholarship Committee. The decision of the Committee is final. The scholarship will be awarded annually at the Mark Anderson Memorial Golf Tournament.

Q: How may the scholarship be used?

A: Scholarship awards must be used for education courses offered within two years after the scholarship is awarded. Any awarded funds not used within that timeframe will be forfeited.

Q: Is the scholarship transferable?

A: No. Scholarship awards are non-transferable and may only be used by the awarded recipient for approved educational purposes.

Q: Does submitting an application guarantee an award?

A: No. Submission of an application does not guarantee selection. All applications are reviewed based on eligibility, chapter involvement, professional commitment, and overall qualifications.
