

PropertyCon: An IREM® Education Experience Scholarship

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Scholarship Applicant

Q: What is the PropertyCon: An IREM® Education Experience Scholarship?

A: The PropertyCon Scholarship is a local scholarship offered by the Las Vegas IREM Chapter to support a member's attendance at PropertyCon: An IREM® Education Experience, IREM's national education and networking conference.

Q: Who is eligible to apply for the PropertyCon Scholarship?

A: Applicants must be current IREM members in good standing. Preference is given to individuals who demonstrate a strong interest in professional development and who would benefit from the education-based sessions and networking opportunities offered at PropertyCon.

Q: What does the PropertyCon Scholarship cover?

A: The scholarship is intended to support conference registration for PropertyCon. Depending on available funds and chapter determination, the scholarship may also support additional expenses as outlined in the application.

Q: Are there expectations beyond attending the conference?

A: Yes. Scholarship applicants should understand that this is an education-based award. Recipients are expected to actively participate in the conference and be prepared to share key learnings with the Las Vegas IREM Chapter following the event.

Q: How do I apply for the PropertyCon Scholarship?

A: Applicants must complete the PropertyCon Scholarship application provided by the Las Vegas IREM Chapter. Application instructions, deadlines, and required materials are outlined in the application.

Q: How will I be notified if I receive the scholarship?

A: Scholarship recipients will be notified directly by the Las Vegas IREM Chapter with award details and next steps.

Q: What are my responsibilities if I am awarded the scholarship?

A: Scholarship recipients are required to return from PropertyCon with five (5) key takeaways from the conference and present those takeaways to the Las Vegas IREM Chapter 99 Board of Directors. This presentation ensures that the educational value of the scholarship benefits the broader chapter.

Q: When and how will the presentation to the Board take place?

A: The timing and format of the presentation will be coordinated with the Las Vegas IREM Chapter following the conference. Recipients will be contacted with scheduling details.

Q: Is the scholarship transferable to another person or event?

A: No. The PropertyCon Scholarship is awarded to an individual recipient and may only be used for attendance at PropertyCon for the designated year.

Q: What happens if I am unable to attend PropertyCon after being awarded the scholarship?

A: Recipients must notify the Las Vegas IREM Chapter as soon as possible if circumstances prevent attendance. Failure to attend or fulfill scholarship obligations may impact eligibility for future scholarships.

Q: Can I apply for other IREM scholarships in addition to the PropertyCon Scholarship?

A: Yes. Applicants are encouraged to explore additional local scholarships offered by the Las Vegas IREM Chapter as well as national scholarships available through the IREM Foundation.
